Don't forget that we will have prayer in the chapel tomorrow afternoon before dismissal. Please join us to pray for all those in our community.

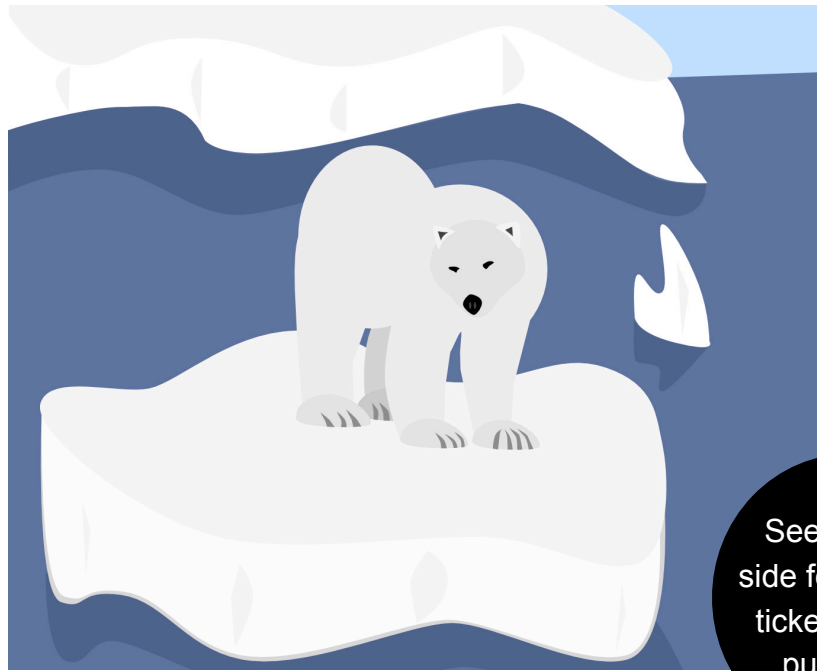
Art Club
