Academic Scholars

Middle School Prep (Grades 6-8) — Get ready, get organized, and succeed. Students will prepare themselves to be organized for the challenges of middle school. In addition, students will review important study skills and note taking skills.

Physical Fitness Scholars

Floor Hockey (Grades 1-4 and 5-8) — Back by popular demand! Whether you are new to the game of hockey or just want to sharpen your skills, the official floor hockey camp of MTRS "Street Devils" is here for you! During the week, we will learn the basics of stick handling, passing, shooting, teamwork, and goal tending. It is a guaranteed workout full of fun drills and scrimmages that will get your blood pumping.
